



Congregate meals are also offered to seniors age 60 and older in the communities of Seeley Lake, Condon/Swan Valley and Lolo.

To participate in a congregate meal, seniors are asked to complete a short intake form at their first meal. Completing this form helps the rural site you choose to maintain funding as a congregate site. Your donations at a congregate meal help support this program as well. Please consider donating an appropriate amount based on your income.

Choose a location that is nearest to you!

Lolo – congregate meals are held Thursdays, 11 a.m. at the Lolo Community Center, located at 12345 Hwy. 93 South. Meals are prepared by a local restaurant and include a hot main dish, salads and dessert.

Condon/Swan Valley – Congregate meals are hosted by the Hungry Bear Steak House on Hwy 83 every Monday and Thursday at 1p.m. Meals include a main dish with vegetable and bread, soup or salad, juice, tea or coffee, and a dessert. Menus are published monthly in the Pathfinder newspaper.

Seeley Lake – Congregate meals are held daily at noon except for Saturday and Sunday at the Sela Senci Senior Center, corner of Locust Lane and Pine Drive in Seeley Lake. Meals are prepared fresh on site and include a main dish, salad bar and dessert.
