Missoula Aging Services is pleased to offer residents of Missoula County age 18 or older the opportunity to receive Ensure products at an affordable cost through the Supplement Program.

To participate in the program, your doctor must provide us a prescription for an Ensure product. If you need a different type of Ensure product you must bring in or have your doctor's office fax a new prescription to 728-7687 to the attention of the "SUPPLEMENT PROGRAM".

***Please make certain your doctor includes:
Your name, address and phone number with your prescription.***

When placing an order for your Ensure product, please call our office 728-7682 at least one day in advance. This will help us make certain the product is available when you arrive. The Receptionist can assist you. Orders can be placed in multiples of 1 six pack (same flavor), or by the case (24 cans). Maximum order is 6 cases (24 six packs) at one time. Refunds are only available for unexpired, unopened six packs of the same flavor.

You may either pick up the order yourself, or make arrangements with a family member or friend to do this for you. Unfortunately we are not staffed to deliver the product. Our office is open Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., excepting certain holidays. We request payment at time of pick-up. We accept cash, SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) check, debit or most credit cards.
